This year our team has invited a different pastor to join their staff meeting every month. They discuss the needs of area congregations and talk about how Journey can help. Pastor Bill Leach of Christ Presbyterian Church in Harrisonburg writes, "At those times when the needs of congregants move beyond the training of the pastor and resources of the congregation, it is a blessing to have a Christian counseling center that has a deep commitment to the work of the church. Over the years I have seen firsthand how God has used the men and women at Journey to bring help, healing and restoration to His people."

Because counseling is expensive, Journey's always used contributions from friends of the ministry to provide financial assistance to clients who can't cover the full cost of counseling (this includes some with large medical bills and others who are out of work).
